

GIFTS TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL

No school employee is to accept any commission or gift from individuals or companies seeking to sell equipment or materials required in the operation of the Holmdel Township Public Schools. The operation of the schools includes the purchase of materials for the construction, repair and maintenance of the school plant; for the conducting of pupil classes; for materials and supplies used in school organizations such as clubs and class projects; and for comparable items.

The Board of Education shall consider as always welcome and most appropriate the writing of letters to staff members expressing gratitude or appreciation.
