SAFETY

The Superintendent shall develop rules governing school safety which shall include but not be limited to: pupil safety in school; care of injured pupils; vehicle safety programs; plant safety including asbestos abatement activities; labeling and storage of hazardous substances; employee safety in school; emergency procedures; pupil safety in transit to and from school; and eye protection. In addition, pupils shall be provided with safety instruction in accordance with the law.

The rules and procedures shall be reviewed and adopted by the Board as required by law and shall be disseminated to students, parents/guardians, school personnel, members of the Board and other appropriate audiences.
