Building Security

The Holmdel Township Board of Education believes that insuring the safety of the students and staff is one of its greatest responsibilities. In addition, the Board feels that its school buildings constitute a major investment of the community. It is in the best interest of pupils and taxpayers to protect that investment adequately.

Security means having locks and being certain that doors are locked at the proper times and monitoring the visitors to district facilities. Security also means:

- A. Minimizing fire hazards;
- B. Reducing the possibility of faulty equipment;
- C. Keeping records and funds in a safe place;
- D. Protecting against vandalism and burglary; and
- E. Prosecuting vandals.

The Superintendent is directed to establish such rules and regulations as may be needed to provide for security in the sense outlined above.

When appropriate, the Board shall obtain expert advise from the Police Department and other individuals and agencies in planning and implementing the security of its facilities.

Vandalism Protection

Every citizen and district resident, all staff members, pupils, and the Police Department are asked by the Board to cooperate in reporting any incidents of vandalism of property belonging to this Board and the names of the person or persons believed to be responsible.
