

POLICY

CONCEPTS AND ROLES IN PUPIL PERSONNEL

Board of Education

The Holmdel Township Board of Education:

- A. Establishes policies to provide the best attainable program of education for district pupils;
- B. Authorizes the establishment of special classes or other facilities for pupils who are in need of special education;
- C. Provides for the facilities and trained personnel to support the physical and intellectual well-being of pupils; and
- D. Determines policies regarding pupil behavior and attendance within the limits of the law.

Superintendent

The Superintendent:

- A. Oversees and monitors the administration of all schools and classes established by the Board of Education;
- B. Directs the instruction, guidance and discipline of all pupils;
- C. Provides leadership and guidance to establish the pattern of education to be offered to pupils;
- D. Has general charge of the enforcement of the compulsory attendance law and the issuance of work permits; and
- E. Has immediate authority for the closing of schools in case of emergencies involving the health and safety of pupils.

Working Relationship Between the Board and the Superintendent

Pupil welfare and guidance is primarily the responsibility of the Superintendent with the exception of the expulsion of pupils, which the Board may not delegate.
