

**INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES
AND RESOURCES**

The Holmdel Township Board of Education believes that personnel and materials appropriate to the needs of the school program must be available to each pupil and teacher.

To be in compliance with the requirements of federal law, the Board of Education directs the Superintendent to distribute curriculum materials and instructional supplies to the schools in such a way that equivalence of such materials is ensured among the schools. Staff assignments shall comply with this directive.

The Board will endeavor to provide the supportive resources and personnel necessary for teachers to implement the approved curriculum in their classrooms and work effectively with children.

It will be the administration's responsibility to set up and maintain such central services for curriculum materials, including audio-visual and technological aids, as are needed, and appropriate channels through which teachers and pupils will be supplied with these resources.

In addition, there will be a library/media center and a library/media specialist in each school of the district to offer children instruction and to provide teachers with assistance in selecting and using learning resources.
